Once again, we will need to raise extra support for health care. We are excited that we have switched to Samaritan Ministries, a Christian health care sharing program. Our cost is \$405/month for the entire family. (\$4,860 for the year) We would greatly appreciate any extra support to cover our health needs for this year. Thank you!
