To the Elderly

At this time we currently visit 20 different nursing homes and assisted living places each month. We usually sing from 30 minutes to an hour at each place. The majority of our time is spent singing either contemporary Christian music or hymns, but they also enjoy sing-a-longs, humorous songs (along with a few of my lame jokes) and some of the old-time songs from years ago. It has been such a joy to serve the elderly in this way. We are so thankful to God for this ministry He has led us to.

To Special Needs

We started just a few years ago singing worship music on Thursday nights with about five special needs friends and now the number is anywhere from 50 to 60. I could never begin to write and explain to you how much we are blessed by our new friends. Every Thursday night is a joy. The Truth Singers meet from September to May with a Christmas party and concert and also a spring concert each year. We also celebrate their birthdays each month and have a dress-up-costume night in October. On Sunday mornings, Annette continues to teach the Truth Singers Sunday school class throughout the year. What a blessing of joy God has brought to us through our special needs friends.

To Marriages

A little less than two years ago, Annette and I went through Matt & Pam Loehr's DARE marriage mentoring training. Since then we have become more and more involved in helping to mentor couples to improve their marriage. This has been an enjoyable and yet sometimes difficult part of our ministry as we long to help encourage couples to put Christ at the center of their marriage and to help them find the joy that God wants for them in their lives together. Both Annette & I are very thankful for the opportunities that God has given us to help others learn how to have a strong, healthy marriage.
