Do you believe? After Jesus' crucifixion, burial, and resurrection, Jesus appeared to his disciples as well as to many others. The Gospel of John chapter 20 records Jesus' encounter with Thomas who had not been with the disciples when Jesus came to them and announced His resurrection. "So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But Thomas said to them, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe." A week later his disciples were in the house again, and Thomas was with them. Though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe." Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!" Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." John ends the chapter with this verse: "But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name." The gift of eternal life is offered by grace through faith in Jesus Christ. Do you believe?
