When God rescued the Israelites from Pharaoh and his armies, they sang praises to Him. (Exodus 15). David's song of praise was given to the Lord in 2 Samuel 22 for delivering him from Saul and his enemies. And in Revelation 14, we read of the redeemed singing a new song before the throne rejoicing over God's redemptive work through His Son Jesus Christ.

The one who turns from sin to Christ and embraces Him as Lord and Savior has been forgiven, saved, and redeemed. He has been purchased by God with a high price, the price of His only Son. He is our Redeemer. We have been redeemed, and of all people on earth, we should sing.
