We were recently asked to share at our church about our ministry and to give an update on how God has been working. Although it was extremely difficult to capture all of God's goodness and faithfulness in the past 23 years of ministry in just 10 minutes or less, we were reminded, as the Israelites were with their stones of remembrance after crossing over the Jordan on dry ground into the Promised Land, of the importance of remembering all that God has done for us and what He continues to teach us.

First of all, we remember God's clear call at the beginning of our ministry. It was with much prayer, Godly counsel, Biblical wisdom, and many confirmations from the Lord that we were convicted of God's call on our lives to serve Him in full time ministry, even though we didn't know what all the details were at the time. We just knew we needed to obey the Lord's call and trust Him for the rest. At different times throughout the years, it has been the remembering of this call that has kept us encouraged and moving forward.

Second, we are to remember God's incredible faithfulness to us. We are humbled and so thankful for not only God's provisions, but His presence and protection over our ministry. Never once has God failed to keep His promises to us!

Thirdly, anything that has been done or accomplished throughout our ministry has been all God's doing and orchestrated by Him. We cannot take credit for anything. God has led us through all the different transitions in our ministry, even when we couldn't see what was next or doubted how it would work. We especially think back to the beginning of the Truth Singers and how God in His goodness began it, has grown it, and has blessed it in ways we never would have imagined, to the praise of His glory.

Next, we are grateful for the work God has done in our own hearts and for the work the Holy Spirit continues to do transforming and sanctifying us. Our lives have been literally changed by the power of God's Word as the Holy Spirit has illuminated Scripture to us in studying the Bible and leading Bible Studies these past 9 years. God's Word truly is "living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart." (Hebrews 4:12) God continues to reveal our own sinful hearts and motives to us and our need for daily repentance as we are confronted with His holiness. God has shown us, and is still teaching us, that we need to show more patience and more grace to others, for God has lavished His grace upon us.

Lastly, we remember Paul's words to the Philippians when he said, "I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, always offering prayer with joy in my every prayer for you all, in view of your participation in the gospel from the first day until now. For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus." Kingdom work is God's work! We can trust God to continue any work He has started. God doesn't need us, but as believers in Christ we are all just humble vessels that God has chosen to use for the advancement of His kingdom wherever God leads. We want to be obedient to whatever that looks like as we "fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God." Hebrews 12:2
