Throughout Scripture we are urged over and over to stand firm, to press on, to hold fast, and to not grow weary. 2 Thessalonians 3:13 reads, "But as for you, brethren, do not grow weary of doing good." Galatians 6:9 says, "Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary." In Revelation, the church in Ephesus was commended for their perseverance. They "endured hardships for my name, and have not grown weary." Again, Hebrews 12:3 repeats the message. "For consider Him who has endured such hostility by sinners against Himself, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart."

And I love what Isaiah 40:28 says. "Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth does not become weary or tired. His understanding is inscrutable." Verse 31 continues. "But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint."

Jesus Christ is the supreme example of endurance. As a result of his faithful obedience to the Father, even to a shameful death on a cross, Jesus is now seated at the right hand of the throne of God. Christ's suffering accomplished salvation for all who believe. In any suffering, difficulty, or trial we go through, God is producing in us the character of righteousness and perseverance. Let us not grow weary in studying and obeying God's Word and telling others that Jesus Christ alone saves!
