### Good Enough?

I once heard someone say, "I'm a nice person. There are a lot of people who do bad things, but I'm not like them. I'm a good person."

People like to think of themselves as good. Maybe it makes us feel better about ourselves when we see others do bad things, things that we would never do. So we compare ourselves to them perhaps to justify ourselves. Just ask anyone if they think they are a good person, and they will most likely say yes, and then tell you the good things that they do. Ask them why they think that God should let them into heaven, and most will likely say because they are good, or at least good enough.

But what does the Bible say about this? It's probably full of verses telling us that people are just naturally good, right?

Well, no, the Bible clearly says something different. God's Word tells us that man is **not** good.

Jeremiah 17:9 says that the heart of man is *"more deceitful than all else and is desperately sick."* Ecclesiastes 9:3 tells us that the human heart is full of evil. And in Romans 9:11, Paul says that no one is

righteous and none seeks after God. And in verse 12 that *"there is none who does good, there is not even one."* People do not recognize the reality of their own sinfulness, and the deception of sin makes people believe the lie that they can please God by being good.

So, what's the point? Why write all of this and make people just feel bad about themselves? Well, the point is this: If people think that by being good or doing good things that they will enter into heaven when they die, and yet God's Word says something completely different from that, then many are in a very dangerous and horrifying situation. I can't think of anything worse than believing that at the moment you die, that you will go to heaven because of your "goodness," only to find out at that very moment you were wrong! And that an eternity of separation from God and heaven is actually what awaits you. That's bad news.

But there is good news. And the same Bible that tells us of the bad news is the very same that tells us the good news. Romans 5:8 says, *"But God demonstrates His own love toward us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."* No humanly good work could ever or would ever be enough to save us. For us to be saved, God would have to do something, and He did. *"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life. For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him."*

What a gracious, loving, kind, heavenly Father. What we as sinful man could never accomplish by our own good works, God accomplished by the sacrifice of His only Son so that we might live forever with Him, if we would only turn from our sin and believe in God's only son, Jesus Christ our Saviour.

*"For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God, not as a result of works so that no one may boast."* Ephesians 2:8-9
